




Artist's Bio

Georgina is an Australian born, USA educated artist raised in Greece, having resided in London's international environment for over a decade. Her cross-cultural background defines her as a person and as an artist.

The pandemic came to unleash her artistic expression through creative work in the arts and in literary writing. Her background as a legal activist lawyer and mediator, as well as her training in psychoanalytical studies informs her artistic sensitivities around injustices involving human rights violations worldwide and enmeshment, avoidance and dominance in relationships.





Title: Golden Boy

Description: When the golden boy realises that the curse of the golden child had been placed on him unknowingly, shock and sadness will overwhelm him. In our admiration of high achievers what often escapes our attention is the darker side of how these human beings learn to live through accomplishing great things. Do they love me or my achievements? Am I my achievements? How much sadness lies in asking the self-such questions. The Golden Boy learns quickly to please and knows he will face the penalty of criticism and abandonment for failure from caregivers and society. And when love is withdrawn he mistakenly understands 'love' as being conditional.

The curse of the Golden Child

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Title: Inner Child Holding

Medium: Oil on Paper

Dimensions: 101cm H x 78 cm W

Description: Inner child holding aims to help viewers gain insight into shared human trauma, as well as well-recognised tools for healing and recovery. This is a visual of holding the self, and the inner child specifically. The protagonist is already on a journey of self-discovery and healing from past trauma and destructive social conditioning. In psychotherapy, holding refers to emotional and mental holding provided to the patient by the therapist. The therapist offers emotional holding by being present, recognising and understanding what the patient is feeling, in a respectful, safe and accepting way. The aim is to make up for the experience that the patient never experienced with the primary caregiver in childhood.






Title: Nuditas virtualis contra criminalis


Medium: Acrylic on Cardboard

Description: The artwork seeks to evoke reactions corresponding to symbolisms of nudity through the prism of nuditas virtualis (purity and innocence) and nuditas criminalis (lasciviousness and vain exhibition) as already clearly established by Christians in the Middle Ages. This ambivalent meaning implies ambiguous emotions: the admiration of moral and spiritual beauty vs the carnal pleasures and irrational attraction rooted in urges beyond the control of the conscious mind and often condemned and shamed by society.





Title: The Dream of Nature's Soul

Description: 'The Earth Has a Soul', comes from a 1958 letter in which Carl Jung, the famous Swiss psychologist expressed his deep concern with man's present disconnection from the environment. Jung held the ancient belief that each country and each person has its personal angel, and that even the Earth itself has its own soul. The dreamlike image depicts how within the therapeutic context dreamwork helps by using symbols originating from mankind's subconscious to signal our need to return to nature.

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Title: Enmeshed love: Opposites attract

Description: "It is all we, and no me". While romantic enmeshment can increase one's sense of belonging in a couple, it can also have a harmful impact. Opposite's enmeshed attraction often leads to unhealthy patterns of coexistence with partners loosing their individual sense of identity and self-esteem. Opposites being diametrically opposed enhances the appeal for each other blurring the boundaries between what is 'me' and what is 'you'.
